- 4. Soap dispensers will not be needed at this time since we will not be getting the shed to store the dispensers in. Ordered smaller units that will be more hand able.
- 5. Image Trend to cancel the current invoice and will update the current agreement that we have.

Old Business:

- 1. Maine is interested in our old Blitz Fire. They need an invoice to present to their Board so they can issue payment of \$1,000.
- 2. Motion made by Griffith, second by Boyer to hire TW Cleaning for light maintenance work as needed for \$25/hour. The board also authorizes him to also make small purchases as required. All Commissioners voted in favor and the motion passed unanimously.
- 3. Training room needs 2 quotes to be submitted to insurance. We do have the quotes from Penn York and Homer Gow & Sons. We need a new lead person to handle this project since Schroedel has a conflict of interest in the project. D. Thomas volunteered to handle the project.

Elec fixed rate for 12 months at 0.0501 kw / 24 months 0.0503kw Gas fixed 12 months at 0.4768 therms / 24 months at 0.4520 therms Motion made by Griffith, second by Boyer to sign contract with Empire for 2 years for both utilities. All Commissioners voted in favor and the motion passed unanimously.

All Commissioners voted in favor and the motion passed unanimously.
